

A Bylaw of the Town of Wilkie Regulating Visibility
at Intersections.

WHEREAS Section 165 Subsection 15 and Subsection 16 of the Urban Municipality Act gives council the authority to prevent the encumbering of streets, lanes and other public places from obstruction.

AND WHEREAS it gives council the authority to regulate the planting of trees, hedges, or shrubs on private property at or adjacent to the street intersections.

NOW THEREFORE the council of the Town of Wilkie enacts as follows:

1. The council may, upon receiving a report, that any hedge, fence, wall or other structure or planting situated at a street corner intersection is dangerous to traffic, by resolution order that such dangerous conditions be corrected by removal or reduced in height to not more than two and one-half (2½) feet above the level of the sidewalk.
2. No fence, hedge, wall or other structure or planting more than two and one-half (2½) feet above the level of the sidewalk shall be erected, placed, or maintained on any corner lot in any R1 or R2 district within a twenty (20) foot distance of the corner of the lot inside or along the said property line frontage or property line flankage.
3. Trees situated on a corner lot in any R1 or R2 district inside or along the said property line frontage or flankage which constitute a hazard to traffic, shall be pruned to a four (4) foot clearance from sidewalk level.

4. Under the authority of this bylaw council may also order the removal of trees, hedges or shrubs already planted; or the removal of any fence, wall or other structure already constructed; or limit the height of such trees, hedges, shrubs, fences, walls or other structure whether planted or constructed before or after the passing of this bylaw.
5. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this bylaw are guilty of an offence and shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw No. A53 of the Town of Wilkie, and in the event the requirements of this bylaw are not carried out, then such person or persons shall be liable for payment of the costs of removal or reduction of any obstruction in this bylaw.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof by the Council of the Town of Wilkie.
